

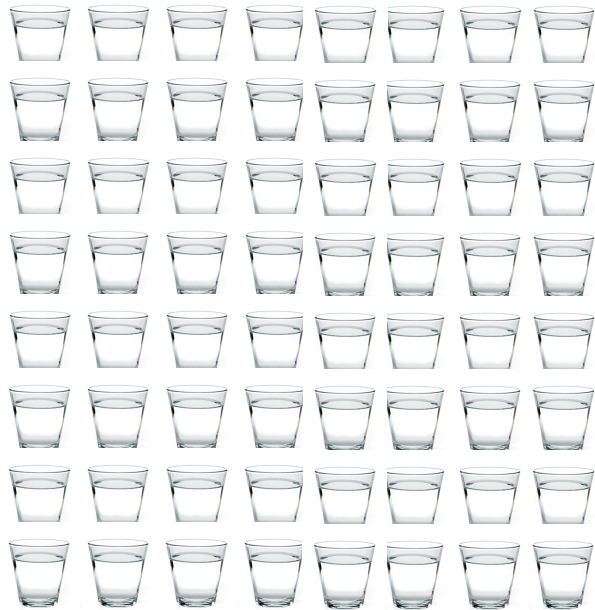


Does it Take Much Water to Make Hydrogen?

Does Hydrogen Electrolysis Use a Lot of Water?

No, the average restaurant uses 6 Times the water of an average hydrogen fuel station



**Average Restaurant
5,800 Gallons/day**

**Average Hydrogen Station
967 Gallons/day
(76 cars or 38 trucks)**



Making Gasoline uses 3.5 times the water of making hydrogen



**4.5 gallons Water to Make
A Gallon of Gasoline**

**1.27 gallons Water
Per Hydrogen Equivalent**
